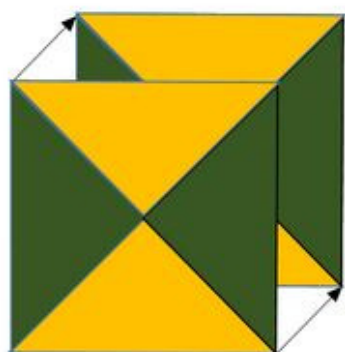


## Sunday Best Quiltworks Half Square Triangle Stencils

Like rulers, our stencils are a one-time purchase. Unlike paper pieced half square triangles, you don't have to shorten your stitch length or waste time removing paper. We draw directly onto the fabric. There are a lot of ways to make half square triangles. Our Half Square Triangle Stencils are designed to produce half square triangles quickly and accurately. They are also designed to save fabric. The only waste is a 1/2" perimeter. Cut your fabric on straight of grain and all of the HST's will be straight of grain. Avoiding bias edges increases accuracy. You can increase the size of any block simply by using a larger HST.

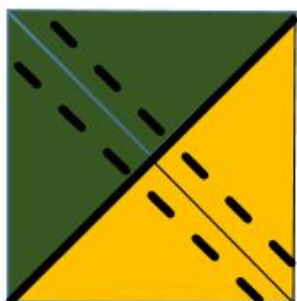

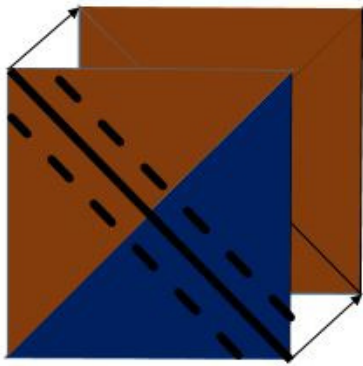


### **Two Color Quarter Square Block**

#### **a.k.a Hour Glass Block:**

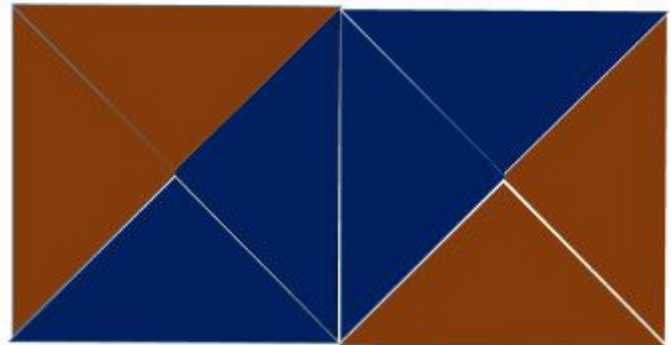
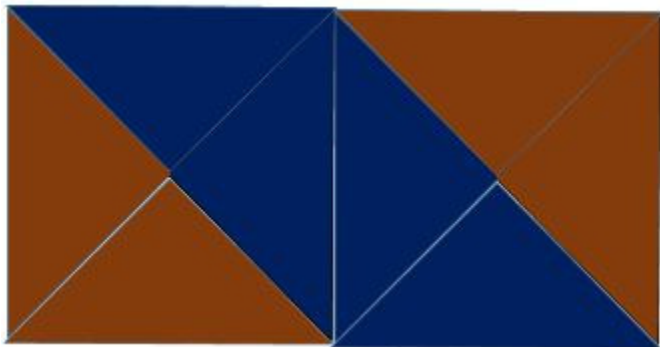
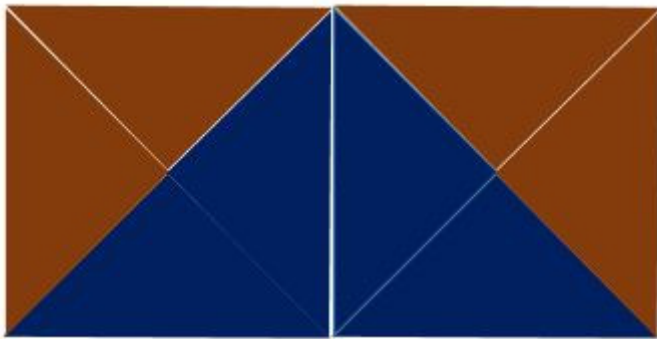
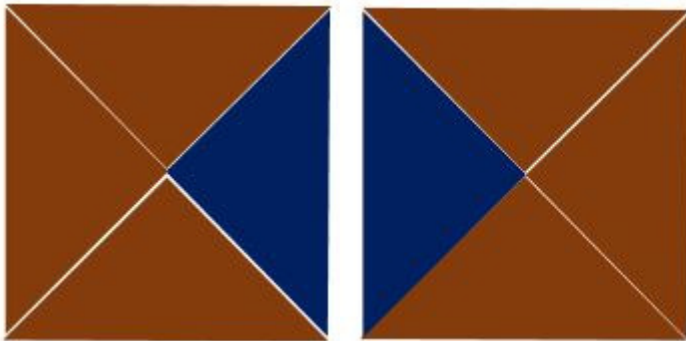
1. Place two half square triangles of the same color right sides together, with opposing colors and seams aligned.
2. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner and then two more lines at 1/4<sup>th</sup> of an inch on either side of the drawn line.
3. Cut on the drawn line and press to one side.
4. This yields two Quarter Square Blocks a.k.a Hour Glass Blocks.





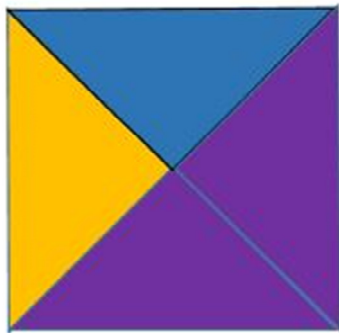
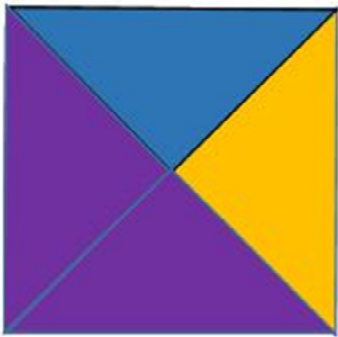
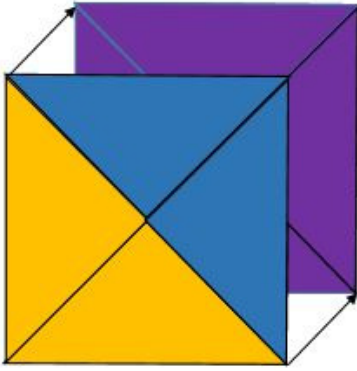
### Two Color Quarter Square Triangles:

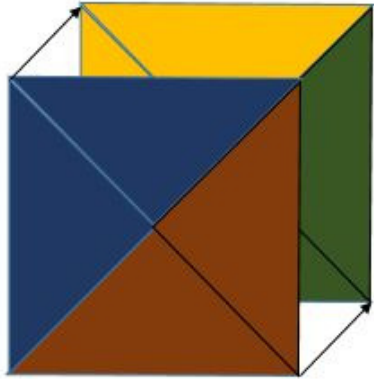
1. Place a sewn Half Square Triangle with a square
2. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the sewn block and stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line
3. Cut on the drawn line and press to one side
4. This will yield two Triple Triangle Blocks



### Three Color Quarter Square Block:

1. Place two half square triangles of different colors right sides together
2. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner and stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line
3. Cut on the drawn line and press to one side.
4. This yields two Quarter-Triangle Blocks.





### Four Color Quarter Square Block:

1. Place a square and a two color half square triangle block right sides together
2. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner and stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line
3. Cut on the drawn line then press to one side.
4. This yields two Triple Triangle Blocks.
